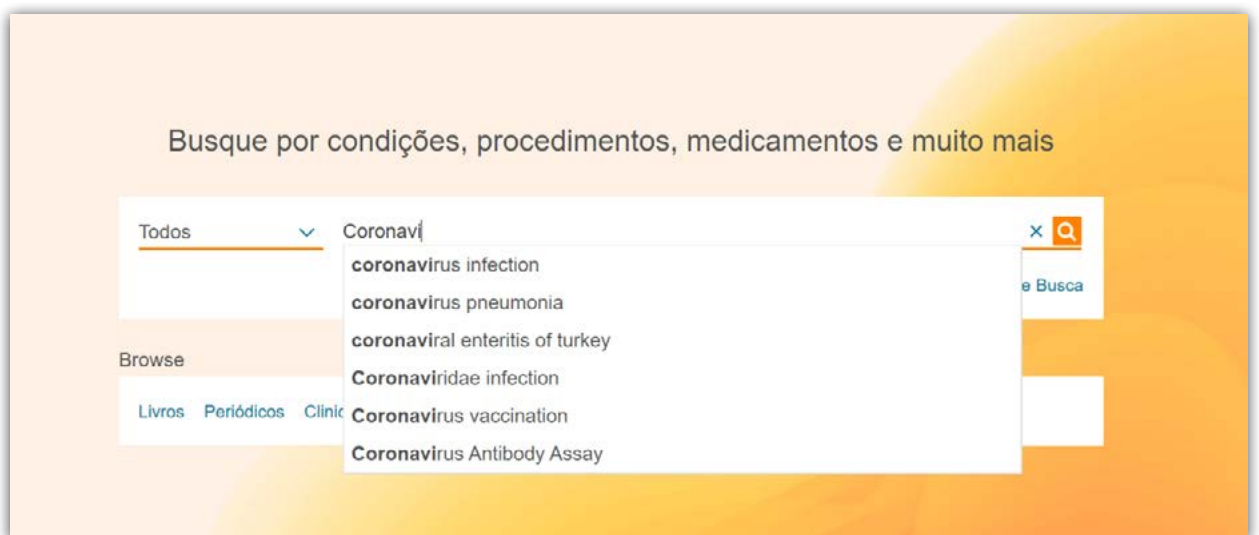

1. Acesse a página inicial do ClinicalKey – www.clinicalkey.com



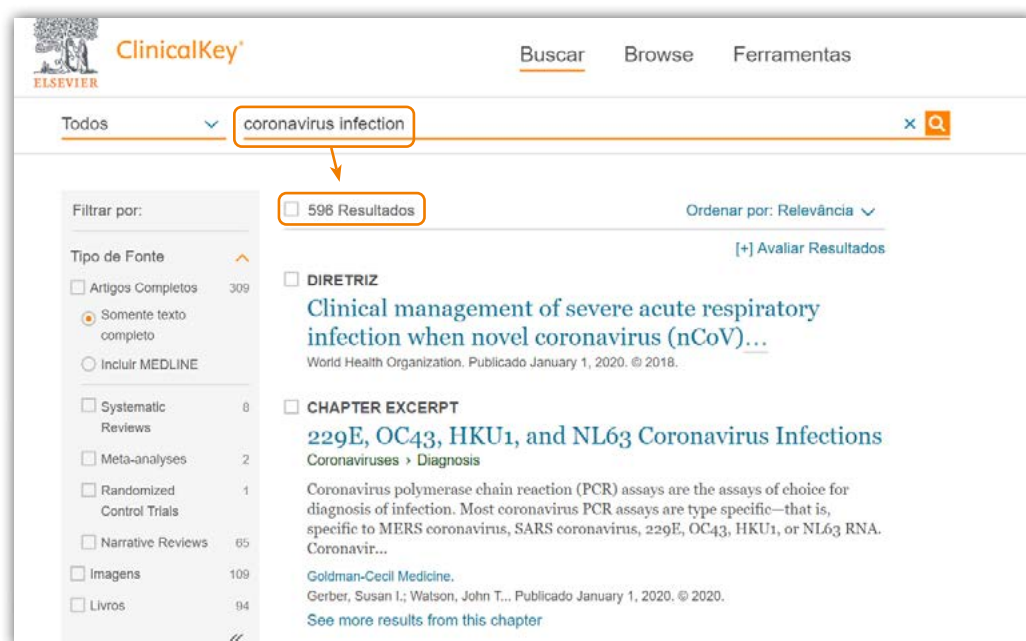
2. Busque no campo a palavra “Coronavirus”.

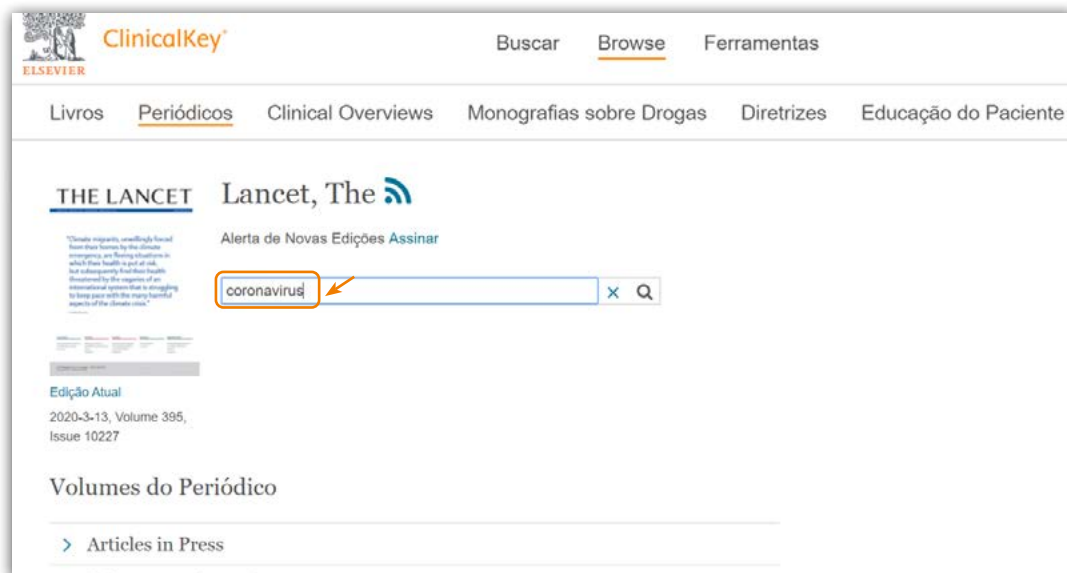
